

# "IZM MENTIONS THE TRUE FACTS"

Salamun alaikum,

We, Akbarali Kasimali Virjee, the President of Imam e Zamana Mission, along with the Secretary Captain Syed Hadi Sadiq, the Treasurer Mr. Mohd Raza Kamdar, the board Members Mr. Salim Peerbhoy, Dr.Syed Tahseen Hussain, Dr. Syed Nawazish Mehdi, and Mr. Syed Abid Kirmani, are desirous of stating the facts about the 'interim agreement' between Sajjadiyya Trust and Imam e Zamana Mission.

To begin with let me specify that Sajjadiyya trust and Imam e Zamana Mission are both charitable organizations with a common goal of imparting education, helping the widows, orphans, etc by providing monthly assistance, housing/shelter by constructing new houses and repairing the existing ones, providing medical aid, facilitating the performance of Qaza Namaz Roza, recitation of Quran for the sawab of Marhoomeen, distribution of food grain during Mahe Ramazan and arranging for Qurbani during Eid uz Zoha.

Alhamdulillah, we greatly value and cherish the long standing relationship with Sajjadiyya Trust, which has taken deep roots over a period of about 30 years and let me assure all our donors, employees, beneficiaries and well wishers that the relationship continues and inshallah, it will be stronger in future too.

There have been demands from the donors and members of the public, to explain about the headlines in social media like youtube, whatsapp, etc stating 'IZM breaks agreement'.

Many of the discussions which take place in the board rooms are not in public domain, but an exception is being made here to make the situation clear to all our esteemed donors and member of public. The following facts will make the matter clear to all concerned.

1. The 'interim' agreement was between Sajjadiya Trust and Imam e Zamana mission only.
2. Imam e Zamana Mission never entered into any agreement with Focus High School or Jism. Not even a draft of any MOU was ever received by IZM, from them after the interim agreement.

3. As President of IZM, I have been in regular contact with the directors of Sajjadiya Trust over phone and via email.
4. On 4<sup>th</sup> April, 2019, I have received an email from Sajjadiya Trust along with the proposed draft of the final agreement.
5. Immediately, I have replied to them stating that certain clauses have been included in the formal agreement which were not part of the 'interim' agreement, like the obligation or commitment to terminate all the employees of schools situated at Yakutpura.
6. Imam e Zamana Mission cannot violate any rules, regulations, conditions, etc imposed on it by the education department, Foreign Currency Regulation Act, etc and to arrive at any final understanding or to conclude any agreement these factors will also have to be considered.
7. I had promised Sajjadiyya Trust to place the copy of the draft final agreement before the IZM board for due consideration, which I have done on 6<sup>th</sup> April, 2019.
8. On 6<sup>th</sup> April, 2019 the IZM board felt that the agreement could not be concluded because the clause about terminating all the employees was impractical and certain conditions of the agreement violated the rules, regulations, conditions, etc of the govt. licensing authorities.

I would like to conclude, while assuring the esteemed donors and members of public that IZM is an ethical and transparent organization of a standing of more than 30 years, which follows the highest standards of accounting and reporting. It has always fulfilled its commitments in the past and inshallah it will always fulfill its agreement or commitments in future too, under the guidance of Imam e Zamana atfs.
